Produced by the Georgia Tech Student Activity Association, Flicks on 5<sup>th</sup> is open to all Tech students and Atlanta area residents. Join us each week at 7pm for pre-movie entertainment, activities and *FREE* popcorn while supplies last. Patrons are invited to bring a lawn chair or blanket and enjoy great eats from Tech Square's restaurants including Tin Drum Asia Cafe, Barrelhouse Tavern, Ray's Ney York Pizza, Waffle House, Moe's Southwest Grill, The Spence, Subway, Gyro King, Yogli Mogli and more.

- June 5 A comedic adventure She's having the time of his life in *Identity Thief*(R)
  About the Movie: When mild-mannered businessman Sandy Patterson (Jason Bateman) is scammed by an identity thief's phone call, he sets out to search for the person who maxed out his credit cards and signed him up for a Florida spa appointment. But the search for the bogus "Sandy" is harder than he thought it would be and is complicated by run-ins with bounty-hunters and others. When he finds the deceptively harmless looking Diana (Melissa McCarthy) who has been living it up at his expense, he confronts her and both "Sandys" find that they have a lot to learn about living life to the fullest.
- June 12 An action packed thriller How far will a father go to save his son? **Snitch** (PG-13)

  About the Movie: In this powerful drama based on a true story, John Matthews (Dwayne "The Rock" Johnson), learns that his estranged son Jason was framed for a drug deal and imprisoned. U.S. Attorney Joanne Keeghan (Susan Sarandon) advises that she will reduce Jason's sentence if John can inform on a drug dealer. The law abiding construction business owner John decides to take matters into his own hands to save the son that he previously left behind for a younger wife and second family. With help from a DEA agent (Barry Peper) and a two-time convict (Jon Bernathal), John sets out to catch the bigger fish that can free his son from prison.
- June 19 8 time Oscar Nominee and an all star cast! *Silver Linings Playbook* (R)
  About the Movie: After being released from a psychiatric hospital for treatment of bipolar disorder, Pat Solitano (Bradley Cooper) moves back in with his parents (Robert De Niro and Jacki Weaver). The former teacher meets and forms a friendship with Tiffany Maxwell (Jennifer Lawrence) a mysterious woman with problems of her own. In an attempt to win back his estranged wife who has a restraining order against him, Pat convinces Tiffany to enter a dance contest as his partner. The two become close as they explore their relationships with each other and their families and learn to cope with their disorders.
- June 26 Can the power of young love conquer a Zombie Apocalypse? *Warm Bodies* (PG 13)

  About the Movie: After a zombie apocalypse, a zombie name R (Nicholas Hoult) spends his days wandering an airport filled with hordes of his fellow undead including his best friend M (Rob Corddry). When R stumbles upon a still human Julie (Teresa Palmer) and her friends forging for medical supplies, R is drawn to her and saves her from a zombie attack. The two build a love so strong that it might transform the entire lifeless world.
